



A DISTINGUISHED LINEAGE - DESCENT OF THE MAIN LINE OF HOUSE OF KARAGEORGE FROM THE HOUSE OF NEMANJA

Sometimes most apparent things are most difficult to spot. It was due to keen eyes and diligence of our young Correspondent Member Mr. Marko Drašković that an obvious line of descent connecting the House of Nemanja with the House of Karageorge was established, and with it a whole network of most remarkable descent lines became apparent no less. We shall start presenting these genalogical ramifications precisely with the descent from Nemanja.

Stefan Nemanja [Saint Simeon].
Grand Zhupan of Rascia 1168-1196, Founder of the Saintly Dynasty of Nemanjić (1113-1199) oo *Ana* (nun Anastasia)

St. Stefan The First Crowned.
Grand Zhupan of Rascia, King of Serbia 1217-1228 oo *Anna Dandollo*, granddaughter of Venetian Doge Enrico Dandollo

St. Stefan Uros I The Great, (monk Symon, +1277), King of Serbia 1243-1276 oo *Helen (St. Helen)*, Princess of Anjou-Sicily

Stefan Dragutin (St. Theoctist, +1316), King of Serbia 1276-1282, King of Srem (1282) oo *Katalin*, Princess of Hungary

Jelisaveta Nemanjić (+1313), Princess of Serbia oo *Stefan / Kotromanic* (+ before 1314), Banus of Bosnia 1289-1310

Stefan II Kotromanic (+1353), Banus of Bosnia 1314-1353 oo *Elizabeth Piast* of Poland, Princess of Kujavia

Katarina Kotromanic, Princess of Bosnia oo *Hermann I of Sanneg*, Count of Cilli (+1385)

Hermann II of Sanneg, Count of Cilli, Sagora, Orthenburg and Sternberg (+1435) oo *Anna* (or *Elizabeth*?) Countess of Schauburg

Barbara of Sanneg, Countess of Cilli, Sagora, Orthenburg and Sternberg oo *Sigismund* of Luxembourg (+1437), King of Bohemia and Hungary, German King, Holy Roman Emperor (1387-1437)

Elizabeth of Luxembourg, Princess of Hungary and Bohemia oo *Albrecht II of Habsburg* (+1439), Duke of Austria, King of Hungary and Bohemia, Roman King (1437-1438)

Elizabeth of Habsburg, Duchess in Austria, Princess of Hungary and Bohemia oo *Casimir IV Jagiellon*, Grand Duke of Lithuania and King of Poland (+1492)

Wladislaw II Jagiellon (+1516), King of Bohemia and Hungary 1471-1490 oo *Anne*, Countess of Foix-Candale

Anne Jagiellon, Princess of Hungary and Bohemia oo *Ferdinand I of Austria* (+1564), Archduke of Austria, King of Bohemia and Apostolic King of Hungary, Holy Roman Emperor 1526-1564

Karl of Austria (+1590), Duke of Styria oo *Maria*, Duchess of Bavaria

Ferdinand II of Austria (+1637), Holy Roman Emperor, Apostolic King of Hungary, King of Bohemia 1619-1637 oo *Maria-Anna*, Duchess of Bavaria

Ferdinand III of Austria (+1657), Holy Roman Emperor, Apostolic King of Hungary and King of Bohemia 1637-1657 oo *Maria-Ana* of Austria, Infanta of Spain

Leopold I of Austria (+1705), Holy Roman Emperor, Apostolic King of Hungary, King of Bohemia 1657-1705 oo *Eleanor*, Countess of the Palatinate-Neuburg

Marie-Anne-Josepha of Austria, Archduchess of Austria, Princess of Hungary and Bohemia oo *Dom João V of Bragança* (+1750), King of Portugal and Algarves 1706-1750

Dom Pedro III of Bragança (+1786)

King of Portugal and Algarves 1777-1786 oo *Dona Maria I of Bragança*, Queen of Portugal and Algarves 1777-1816

Dom João VI of Bragança (+1826), King of Portugal and Algarves 1816-1826 oo *Carlotta of Bourbon*, Infanta of Spain

Dom Pedro I (IV) of Bragança (+1834), King of Portugal and Algarves, Emperor of Brazil 1822-1831 oo *Leopoldina of Habsburg*, Archduchess of Austria

Dona Maria II of Bragança (+1853), Queen of Portugal and Algarves 1826-1853 oo *Ferdinand II*, Prince of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha (+1885), King-Consort of Portugal and Algarves 1836-1885

Antonia of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha-Braganca, Princess of Portugal oo *Leopold* (+1905), Prince of Hohenzollern-Sigmaringen

Ferdinand I of Hohenzollern-Sigmaringen (+1927), King of Romania 1914-1927 oo *Mary*, Princess of Great Britain and Saxe-Coburg-Gotha

Marioara of Hohenzollern-Sigmaringen (+1961), Princess of Romania oo *Aleksandar I Karageorgevich* (+1934), King of the Serbs, Croats and Slovenes, King of Yugoslavia 1922-1934

Petar II Karageorgevich (+1970), King of Yugoslavia 1934-1970 oo *Alexandra of Schleswig-Holstein-Sonderburg-Glücksburg* (+1993), Princess of Greece and Denmark

Aleksandar II Karageorgevich, Crown Prince of Yugoslavia and Serbia, born in 1945.
