ПРОЈЕКАТ ГРБА НИШКЕ ЕПАРХИЈЕ С.П.Ц. PROJECT OF THE COAT OF ARMS OF THE SEE OF NIS OF THE SER-BIAN OR- THODOX CHURCH

Пројект грба Нишке епархије С.П.Ц. израђен је још пре више година, али још увек није формално усвојен. Основно решење је истоветно садржеју штита који је својевремено др Палавестра предложио за грб града Ниша (*оцилним резом раздељено златно и плаво, а у горњем делу златни хризмон између алфе и омеге*). Девиза је, наравно, *ΕΙ ΤΟΥ ΤΟ ΙΚΩ*.

The project of the Coat of Arms of the Serbian Orthodox See of Nis had been prepared some years ago, but so far it has not been officially adopted. The content of the shield is same as the one previously proposed by Dr Palavestra to serve as Municipal armorial achievement for City of Nis.

Умро је Емон О'Тул (1921-2001), славни ирски фалеристичар, који је утро нове путеве познавању ирске фалеристике, али и егзотичних подручја као што су Малезија и њене савезне државе, или одликовања индијских кнежевина. Био је ветеран 2. Светског рата, ратни пилот, а после рата служио је у Немачкој, Грчкој, Палестини, Малаји, Сингапуру и Хонг Конгу. Оснивач је Ирског друштва за проучавање медаља.

Eamonn O'Toole (1921-2001), famous Irish phalerist, died in August. He was a man of action and knowledge, and his books on Irish and Malayan Orders and Medals brought this fascinating theme to the international attention. Eamonn O'Toole was 2nd WW veteran, a fighter pilot, and after the War ended served in Germany, Greece, Palestine, Malaya, Singapore and Hong Kong.
